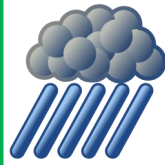

How do I get AmazonSmile?

- ✦ Log in to your Amazon account
- ✦ Search Longwood Primary School in the 'Pick your own charity' search bar
- ✦ Select the Longwood Primary School.
