- Design an leaflet or poster about Fairtrade.

It doesn't matter if it's not perfect - encourage them to have a go by themselves at first :)

Parents - how to help your child:

- Ensure that your child brings their library book to school every Monday and their home readers/tricky word tubs on a Friday (if they have one).
- Practice adding/subtracting and doubling to 20 using objects/bar modelling.
- Encourage your child to read their tricky words and books as often as possible.
- Point out numbers in the environment and ask them one more and one less.
- Encourage them to be writing proper sentences including finger spaces about anything that they like using their phonic fingers.
