Application and Reasoning Noun Phrases

Developing

1a. Various answers, for example: the little cat

2a. Various answers, for example: The excited dog ran away.

The scared children ran away.

3a. He is not correct because although he has underlined the noun phrase 'The black cat' he has also underlined 'is' which is not part of the noun phrase.

Expected

4a. Various answers, for example: The happy kitten jumps over the wall.
5a. Various answers, for example: <u>They</u> chased after <u>the black dog</u>.
<u>He</u> chased after from <u>the evil prince</u>.
6a. He is not correct because he has not underlined 'old' which is part of the expanded noun phrase and he has not underlined the pronoun 'him'.

Greater Depth

7a. Various answers, for example: He silently crept into the enormous cave where he found a huge dragon sleeping on a pile of gold.

8a. Various answers, for example: <u>Some</u> of them climbed <u>the tall tree</u> and looked out for <u>the ruthless pirates</u> returning. <u>Others</u> scattered <u>the priceless coins</u> in the sand but it was too late.

9a. He is not correct as 'That man's grumpy' is not a noun phrase. These sentences do no contain a noun phrases but he should have underlined the pronoun 'him'.

Application and Reasoning Noun Phrases

Developing

1b. Various answers, for example: the round man2b. Various answers, for example: The <u>old</u>

lady sat crying.

The <u>lost child</u> sat crying.

3b. She is not correct because she has underlined the verbs 'is hopping' rather than the noun phrase 'The small rabbit'.

Expected

4b. Various answers, for example: The excited girl watched the funny clown.
5b. Various answers, for example: <u>It</u> flew towards <u>the tall mountains</u>.

<u>They</u> flew towards <u>the hot sun.</u>

6b. She is not correct because although she has underlined the expanded noun phrase and one pronoun, she has also underlined the verb 'wept' and missed the pronoun 'she'.

Greater Depth

7b. Various answers, for example: She cut the wire quickly, hoping she wouldn't set off the loud alarm and manage to lose the sneaky criminal.

8b. Various answers, for example: <u>She</u> crawled through <u>the damp sewers</u> because she needed to find a way out of the city. <u>She</u> hid <u>the precious jewels</u> in a crack in the wall and followed <u>the dim</u> <u>light</u> at the end of the tunnel.

9b. She is not correct as although 'her brain is rather inventive' contains the same words as a noun phrase, it isn't a noun phrase. She should have underlined 'her' and 'many vivid worlds'.
