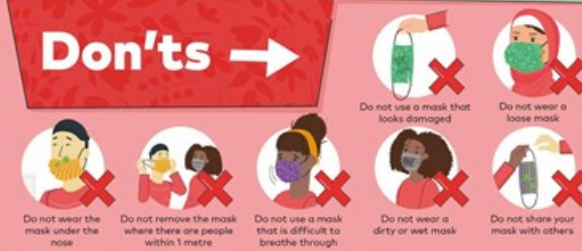
## HOW TO WEAR A NON-MEDICAL FABRIC MASK SAFELY
