Please be aware that, this year, due to Covid 19, no gifts can be accepted or exchanged between pupils and/or staff for Christmas.

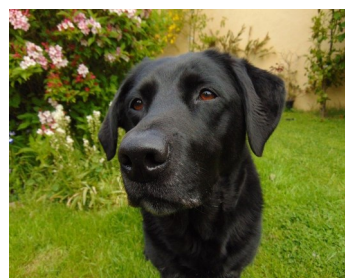
