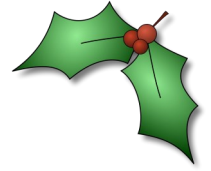
Lunchtimes will continue to be at the normal allocated times and at the subsidised cost of £1.50.

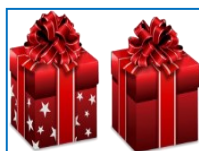
Please contact the school office if your child will require a vegetarian option.
